～Notice Regarding Operations Due to the Impact of Typhoon No. 13～

Thank you for visiting JUNGLIA OKINAWA.

Following the passage of Typhoon No. 13, we have been conducting safety inspections and restoration work throughout our facilities. However, as additional time is required to ensure that we can safely welcome our guests, the park will be closed for the entire day on Sunday, August 9.

SPA JUNGLIA will open at 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 9. The adjoining TROPICAL OASIS restaurant is also scheduled to operate as usual.

■ Operations on Sunday, August 9 and Monday, August 10

【Sunday, August 9】

- Park: Closed for the entire day
- SPA JUNGLIA: Open from 2:00 p.m.
※Depending on the circumstances, some facilities may open gradually as they become ready.

【Monday, August 10】

- Park: Scheduled to operate as usual
- SPA JUNGLIA: Scheduled to operate as usual

※Please note that the availability or operation of certain facilities may change due to restoration work and final safety inspections following typhoon-related preparations.

■ Park Tickets for Sunday, August 9

Guests who purchased park tickets for Sunday, August 9—including 1-Day Tickets, Park & Spa 1-Day Tickets, FURATTO Tickets, Royal Tickets, and Premium Passes—will receive automatic refunds. No contact or application is required.

Please note that refund processing may take some time depending on the payment method used at the time of purchase.

■ Ticket Date Changes

JUNGLIA OKINAWA offers complimentary date changes for eligible purchased tickets. If you wish to change your scheduled visit date, please consider using the date change service.

■ Operation of HORIZON BALLOON

Due to strong winds caused by Typhoon No. 13, a windborne object came into contact with the HORIZON BALLOON attraction, damaging part of its envelope. As a result, the attraction is expected to remain temporarily closed until further notice.

As the park was closed during the passage of the typhoon, no guests or employees were injured. There is also no risk of debris scattering into the surrounding area.

We sincerely apologize to everyone who was looking forward to experiencing HORIZON BALLOON for the inconvenience. We will continue restoration work with the aim of resuming operations as soon as possible.
